Grants for the XXIInd International Congress in Paris

The ISR Grant Committee

The ISR is pleased to announce that a number of grants for travel to the XXIInd International Congress in Paris will be made available. The size of the grants will be determined by travel expenses as well as the number of applications approved. The maximum grant will be CHF 500. Priorities for awarding the grant are as follows:

1. Applicants from developing countries
2. Students and recent graduates who are presenting at the Congress
3. Students and recent graduates who are attending but not presenting at the Congress

**Interested individuals should submit the application form between November 1st, 2016 and January 31st, 2017 to the Grant Committee c/o Odile Husain, Ph.D. at the following email address: travelgrants@rorschachParis2017.org
Grants will be announced by March 31st, 2017.**

The following documents are requested along with the filled in application form:

1. For students, proof of enrollment in a university or other accredited school of psychology
2. For recent graduates, copy of graduate diploma or certificate
3. Brief Curriculum Vitae of the applicant
4. Reference letter from an ISR member of a national society or an individual member of the ISR or a licensed psychologist, if the applicant comes from a country which has no national society, as well as his or her email
5. Airline ticket or booking or other indication of other means of transport
6. Abstract for applicants who are presenting at the Congress

Please note the following:

1. Applications will only be examined **after full payment has been made for the congress registration** and has been confirmed by the Organizing Committee of the Congress. Link: <http://www.rorschachparis2017.org/Inscription/en>
2. No incomplete submission will be examined.
3. The grants will be announced by March 31st, 2017. There will be no appeal process and the Grant Committee will not provide justification for its decisions.
4. Recipients of a travel grant from the ISR who cancel their congress registration during the period when a refund is still possible will only obtain their refund after they reimburse the full amount of the travel grant to the ISR.

Payment by the ISR: Applicants will obtain payment through a wire transfer in CHF to **their** bank account. They may choose to receive it:

1. Before the congress
2. After the congress
